Guide Lines

- I. A candidate for the “Hall of Fame” need not meet each and every item on the criteria list set forth by the board, but must be recognized as an outstanding contributor to the club.
- II. There should be no more than three candidates inducted into the “Hall of Fame” at any one time, unless there are special circumstances.
- III. The “Hall of Fame” is not necessarily a yearly event, but is based on the nomination and approval of candidate.
- IV. A nomination can be made by any active member of the camera club however; they can not be related directly or indirectly to the nominee.
- V. A club member can only nominate one candidate per calendar year
- VI. Nominations must be made on the official “Hall of Fame” form which can be obtained from a board member or found on the Grand Rapids Camera Club website.
- VII. Nomination forms must be submitted to a board member by November 1, to be reviewed at the November board meeting.
- VIII. All nominations will be reviewed by the board for eligibility based on the criteria.
- IX. The “Hall of Fame” award will be presented at the February awards banquet.
- X. The “Hall of Fame” plaque will be displayed at the awards banquet and periodically at club meetings.
